










## **MAP OF THE AREA**









## RESIDENCE PERMIT RENEWAL AND APPOINTMENTS



**PROCEDURE 1: POSTAL KIT** 

#### Through this procedure, it is possible to request/renew/convert residence permits for:

- subordinate/self-employed work
- family reasons
- pending employment
- political asylum (renewal)
- study
- EU long-term residence permit
- permanent residence card for family members of the EU citizen who do not have the citizenship of an EU member state. Art.17 Legislative Decree 30/2007
- residence card for family members of the EU citizen who do not have the citizenship of an EU member state. Art.10 Legislative Decree 30/2007



#### It is possible to request appointments online for:

- residence permit due to pregnancy (Art. 28 Presidential Decree 394/99 in conjunction with Art.19 Paragraph 2 Letter D) Legislative Decree 286/98)
- residence permit for medical treatment (Art.19 Paragraph 2 Letter D-Bis) Legislative Decree 286/98)
- residence permit for minor assistance Art. 31 paragraph 3 Legislative Decree 286/98
- conversion of the residence permit from subsidiary protection to subordinate/selfemployed work purposes
- travel document for refugees/stateless persons and travel document for foreigners
- first electronic residence permit issued following a positive decision
- electronic residence permit (subsidiary protection and special protection)
- renewal of paper residence permit for asylum request

Legalization consists of certifying the legal status of the Public Official who placed his signature on an original document (photocopies and electronic signatures cannot be legalized), as well as the authenticity of the signature itself but does not certify in any way the authenticity of the content of the legalized document.

The Prefecture provides for the legalization of signatures on documents to and from abroad.

Except in exceptional cases, the document presented at the desk on Monday will be collected on Monday the following week; if the document is presented on Thursday, it will be possible to collect it on Thursday the following week.

**ALTERNATIVELY**, it is possible to send the documents to be legalized by post, including ordinary mail, to the address: Prefecture of Lodi – Legalization office, C.so Umberto I, 40, 26900 Lodi.

### **FAMILY REUNIFICATION**

- Once the authorization for reunification has been obtained from the One-Stop Immigration
  Desk, the family members who need the requested authorization can apply for an entry
  visa into Italy to the competent Italian diplomatic-consular authority for the country of
  origin at the time of the request, presenting the certification attesting to the relationship
  of kinship, marriage, minor age and any necessary civil status document, duly translated
  and legalised.
- Once the entry visa has been obtained, the reunited family members, within 8 days of their entry into Italy, must request an appointment to complete the first entry procedure at the One Stop Shop for Immigration by writing to <a href="mailto:protocollo.preflo@pec.interno.it">protocollo.preflo@pec.interno.it</a>
- The One Stop Immigration Desk issues reunited family members with a receipt for collecting the First Residence Permit for Family Reunification at the Police Headquarters in Lodi.



- The employer who has submitted an application to hire a worker residing abroad is informed of the release of the hiring authorization, valid for a period of six months. At the request of the employer himself, the One Stop Shop for Immigration transmits the authorization to the diplomatic representation of the worker's country of residence. The consular offices of the foreigner's country of residence or origin will, after the necessary checks, issue the entry visa.
- **Upon arrival in Italy**, the foreigner must communicate their entry to the SUI by writing to the certified email address *protocollo.preflo@pec.interno.it*, attaching a copy of the visa and entry stamp. This is followed by a summons at the Prefecture's One Stop Desk, indicating the day and time of presentation and the necessary documentation, in order to proceed with signing the residence contract. To sign the contract, the presence of both the employer and the worker is required.









- It shows that you are living permanently in one place
- You can apply at the registry office of the municipality of reference
- You must prove that you actually live in that house by providing the required documentation to the municipality
- The local police will check your house to verify that you actually live there



**Residency allows** you to access many services, receive assistance and find a job more easily. Remember to transfer your residence every time you move house (you must always go to the registry office of your municipality) otherwise it will be canceled by the municipality.



The **Registry Office** (of your municipality of residence) is the place where you can request:

- the Certificate of residence
- Italian Citizenship
- the family state

### **DECLARATION OF HOSPITALITY**



It's a document that says where you live.



- You must fill out a form to be stamped by the local police in your municipality within 48 hours.
- You can find the form at the following link: <u>https://www.infoimmigrazione.com/wp-content/uploads/Dichiarazione-di-ospitalita.pdf</u>

N.B: anyone who provides accommodation or hosts a foreigner or stateless person, even if it's a relative or a similar case, or transfers to the same the ownership or enjoyment of real estate, rustic or urban property, located in the territory of the State, is required to give written communication within 48 hours, to the local public safety authority.

- It means that the declaration of hospitality can also be filled in by whoever is hosting you.
- The anti-terrorism law requires it. You need it to renew your residence permit at the Police Headquarters. This is why it is very important!



### WHO IS IT DELIVERED TO?

To the Local Police headquarters of the municipality of domicile/residence (where you live).

## IN ITALY IT IS REQUIRED TO HAVE A GENERAL PRACTITIONER



For prescriptions, medical visits, hospital visits, medicines, illness certificates and consultancy. Emergency rooms are ONLY for emergencies.

## CHOOSING AND CHANGING THE GENERAL PRACTITIONER



- Through the Web Portal of the administrative services of the ASST of Lodi which allows the processing of all Choice and Change procedures without having to reach out to desks.
- Access to the portal is provided, upon registration, at the link: https://hplo.asst-lodi.it/SIOC/
- You'll have to carry it out personally from home (only for changes of practitioner/income exemptions) on the ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORD via CNS if in possession of the access PIN, SPID or CIE (Electronic Identity Card).



Request an appointment to access the desk via:

- the "Salutile Prenotazioni" App allows you to book health visits and diagnostic tests directly from your smartphone or tablet for you and your family. The App is available free of charge for Android devices (on Google Play, Huawei App Gallery) and iOS (Apple App Store).





- the **Regional Contact Center**, from Monday to Saturday from 08.00 to 20.00, by calling the toll-free number from a landline 800.638.638 or 02 99.95.99 from a mobile network for a fee, according to your tariff plan.
- Once the request for the choice of general practitioner and family paediatrician has been forwarded, the ASST of Lodi will issue a temporary paper form valid until the plasticized health card is received by post. If the process is done online, the paper form can be directly printed by the user following the instructions provided.


